

Tromsø City: Culture and Tradition (2hrs)

Minimum 10pax, NOK 130pp

Includes visit to North Norwegian Art Museum, Perspektivet Museum, City Walk, and authorized Tromsø Guide commenting all two hours in your own language!

1) In the first part of this City Walk your guide will show you the Roald Amundsen Monument, the small Prostneset Pier, the bust of Richard With (founder of the Coastal Steamer), the old beach line (Sjøgata), and some Imperial style houses.

2) The North Norwegian Art Museum holds exhibits from the so called Lofoten painters; in the early 19th century many European and Norwegian artists temporarily moved to Lofoten in their search for inspiration. You can find some of the results of this cultural trend in this excellent Museum.

3) In the second part of the City Walk your guide will show you the Northern Most Protestant Cathedral, Roald Amundsen's place, Mack: the Northern Most Brewery, Ølhallen: the oldest pub in town, the Art Association, the Polar Institute, Polaria, the vessel Polstjerna, you will walk along a rundown quay behind the Brewery, you will enter the Nerstranda Shopping Mall, your guide will show you the Skarven restaurant and the Train Station pub, you will continue walking Storgata (the main street) until it turns into a pedestrian street, then your guide will show you the Library, the City Hall, the Northern Most Catholic Cathedral, the Market Place, the Fishermen Monument, some old wooden warehouses by the sound, the Polar Museum, Skansen: the oldest house in town, the small shipyard where Amundsen built the vessel Gjøa, some old worker houses, some more Imperial Style houses in their Trondheim and Bergen versions, and the old Cinema.

4) The Perspektiv Museum holds historical and contemporary exhibits about people and events characterizing the city of Tromsø. This museum was built in what used to be the house of writer Cora Sandel.
